

**Flathead CORE**  
**January 10, 2013**

1. Update for CORE website – Chany – first we tackled the big problems with just getting the website to load, and now we are starting to do more fine-tuning of how it looks. Chany will be helping us with this and then creating a “training manual” for us on how to make edits to the site on our own.
2. Earth Day (April 22) – FVCC has a link to the events from last year, [www.fvcc.edu/2012/fvcc-to-host-earth-matters-week](http://www.fvcc.edu/2012/fvcc-to-host-earth-matters-week) . They had a family carnival last year and perhaps that could be something we could help with. Mary Jo said she would contact FVCC and Melissa Sladek to start thinking about how we could be involved.
3. [Winter Trails Day events](#) are happening this weekend. A press release went out this week from Flathead National Forest and mentioned Flathead CORE. Lone Pine has free snowshoe rentals from 10-5 p.m. that day. They have the snowshoes for rental all winter (sizes = 4 medium, 3 larges, 7 youth, cost is \$5). Whitefish Legacy Partners is working with Stillwater Lodge and Ravenwood to host the event from 10 – 2 p.m. Swan Ecosystem Center is doing snowshoe hike for any beginners. A suggestion was made that we should email this info. to places like Blacktail and Big Mountain to let them know about it. Glacier NP will have their 10:30 and 2 p.m. walks. (It says 1:30 in the press release but it is actually 2 p.m. and these walks will continue every weekend until March 17.)
4. [Forest for Every Classroom](#) – is happening out of Missoula and the Flathead is trying to replicate this training. The MT Natural History Association is interested in being the lead host organization for the administrative body for the project. They would need a steering committee set up here. We need to make that decision to start planning for next fall. Patti is going to present it to the Flathead Conservation Board, Evie and Amy are tentative depending on time commitment, Diann Ericson, Laura Law and Sheena would be interested in helping. Pattie will contact MT NHC to find out what the time commitment would be for folks on the steering committee.
5. [Foys to Blacktail](#) – has been working on putting together a public workshop to gather information about local education needs (where we need to fill in holes and such). *Wilderness Investigations (WI) is a new wilderness education program offered by the Arthur Carhart National Wilderness Training Center. This rigorous, standards-correlated, and place-based toolkit includes live teacher training workshops, printed and downloadable teaching materials, online investigation-specific training, and a WI teacher networking site for sharing, problem-solving, and WI program announcements. WI topics are focused on key elements of the Wilderness Act of 1964 and include classroom, field, and family components. Every WI investigation includes project-based/hands-on activities, and many lead to service learning opportunities. WI is subject-integrated and geared mainly to 5th-8th grade audiences (but is easily adapted for other grades).*
